Minutes

Community Development Director Peterson called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.

Article 1. Kent Conservation District – Invasive species

Peterson explained that he is waiting for a quote from the conservation district for all of our parks. Once we get the quote we will be able to make a recommendation to the Township Board. The Committee felt that it would be more efficient to have the conservation district do the work rather than the grounds crew.

Article 2. Pickleball at Cascade Rec Park.

Peterson explained that we have some interest from park users to install pickleball courts at the Cascade Recreation Park. Peterson did have our engineer give some cost estimates for new or tennis court conversion. The costs ranged from 30k to 130k. The Committee asked Peterson to see if we could temporarily use a couple of the tennis courts. Peterson will follow up with the group that has expressed interest to see if this would be possible. We could then measure interest.
