NO rips, tears, stains, burns, pet hair, odors, holes, mold, bed bugs,  
excessive or deep scratches.

Appliances, computers, electrical, mechanical items in good working order and  
appearance, free of any safety defects.

Toys: non-toxic, contain no pthalates, lead paint, not a recalled product, parts  
larger than 1.25"X 2.25".

Donated items must be on the main level of home, garage, or outside at ground  
level in one area with easy access.

**DONOR MUST BE PRESENT FOR IN-HOME OR GARAGE PICK UP.**

Please disassemble beds, disconnect appliances except **Refrigerators, Freezers  
& Air Conditioners** that must be plugged in showing that they cool/  
freeze sufficiently.
